1 Install Seismic Brackets (Optional) KK

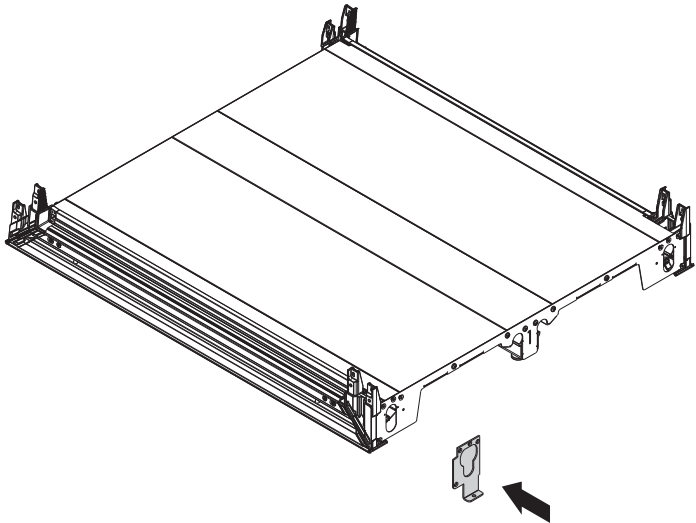
- The Building's Engineer of Record (EOR) must be consulted to determine if anchoring is needed to meet seismic or other Building Code requirements.

- Secure brackets to the building with hardware specified by the EOR and per the hardware manufacturer's instructions.



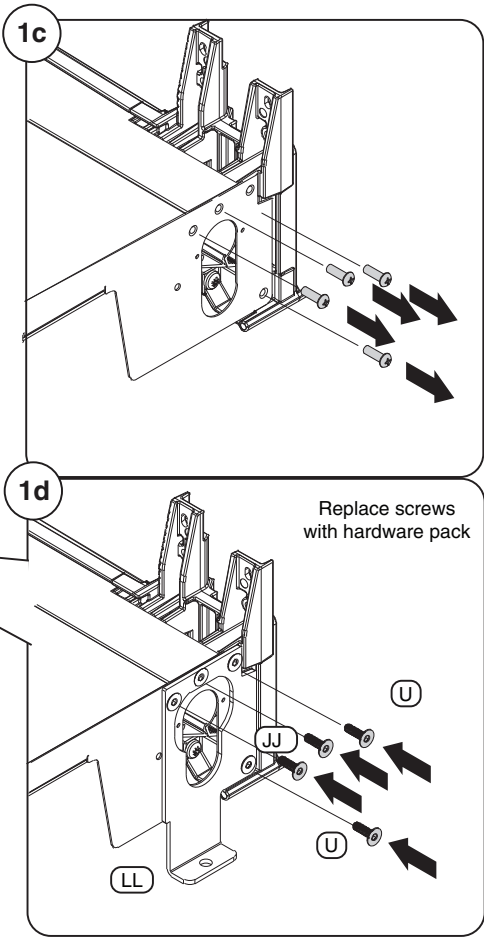
